1. ENTRY FEES:

All Classes	\$15
Office Fee	\$10 per horse

2. **ENTRIES** must be made on the entry form provided. No entry will be accepted without signature of owner and rider. The signature of the parent or guardian of each minor rider is also required. Entries may be made the day of the show. Show office will open at 2:00p. m. on Saturday and 7:00 am on Sunday. For convenience, you may enter on-line. Go to: www.horseshowtime.com

3. **STALLS** are limited! **Stalls will be reserved on a first come, first served basis and MUST be reserved with payment by Monday, February 23, 2009.** The cost of stalls will be \$60/day or \$100/weekend. **RESERVE YOUR STALLS EARLY!!** For Stalls contact: Linda McClaren at 573-590-3661.

4. **CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS** (within 12 Months) certificate must be shown before numbers will be issued.

5. **SCHOOLING** will be permitted from 2 p.m. until 4 p.m. FOR JUMPERS ONLY on Saturday and from 6 a.m. until 7:30 a.m. in the show ring on Sunday morning. There will be no schooling after the show on Saturday. Hard hats are required.

6. **RIBBONS & AWARDS** - Ribbons to sixth place in every class. Fabulous prizes will be awarded to the winner of the Jumper Classic. Championship Ribbons will be awarded in all Hunter Divisions, except Warm up and Equitation.

7. **PETS** must be kept on a leash at all times, or they will be impounded and returned to their owners for a \$50.00 fee.

8. **CLASSES** may be cancelled, combined, or divided if necessary.

9. **SHOW COMMITTEE DECISIONS** shall be final and will be guided by MHS and MOHJO Rules where applicable.

10. **NON-COMPETING HORSES** - need to register with the secretary and pay a schooling fee of \$10.00. A current Coggins test also need to be presented.

11. **CONCESSIONS** - There will be food available on the show grounds.

On Saturday and Sunday, March 7-8, 2009, the William Woods University Hunter Jumper Show Team is hosting a two day Winter Fun Show. The hunter jumper show offers classes for a wide range of riders: from exciting Jumper classes on Saturday afternoon to Hunter Over Fences on Sunday. It is our mission for this show to be a fun, affordable competition for riders from many disciplines, offering a WARM, fun filled atmosphere with a variety of classes, good food, and quality prizes and ribbons.

The 2009 Winter Fun Show is recognized by the Missouri Horse Shows Association and the Missouri Hunter Jumper Organization. The Winter Fun Show has won many Horse Show of the Year awards in its category. Limited stalls are available, though the close proximity of warmup and showing arenas makes it easy for competitors to show out of their own trailers. There will be no admission charge for spectators.

The 2009 Winter Fun Show is being put on to benefit the student organization called the WWU Hunter/Jumper Show Team. The proceeds of the show are utilized in defraying the cost for our students to attend a national level horse show during the Spring semester. Because this show is offering a wide variety of classes, quality prizes and ribbons, the 2009 Winter Fun Show is seeking sponsorships. All sponsor names will be posted on a large display wall, announced with the presentation of awards in their respective classes, and will be listed in the program to be handed out the day of the show. 5. Rotating Pair Relay This competition is for teams of two. A horse can only compete once in this class, but a rider may compete on more than one horse. The entire course must be jumped twice in the correct order by either competitor. The competitor who crosses the start line must jump the first obstacle and the competitor who jumps the last obstacle must cross the finish line. Each horse/rider team must participate in both courses. Competitors may change over as often as they wish. A change is required whenever a fault is incurred. A fault is indicated by an audible signal at which time the other competitor continues the course from the next obstacle. In the event of a disobedience, the other competitor must first jump the obstacle which has not been jumped by his partner and then continue the course. Faults incurred are penalized by adding four seconds for each occurrence to the time of the round. The first three disobediences are penalized only by time, the fourth disobedience incurs elimination. Should a competitor jump an obstacle before his partner has landed over the preceding obstacle, the pair will be eliminated. The fastest overall time wins. In case of a tie for first place only, there will be a compulsory jump-off over a shortened course.
