## Welcome to the Fall 2017 WWU Jumping Derby!!

The 2017 Jumping Derby is being put on to benefit the Hunter/Jumper Show Team, who will use the proceeds toward defraying the cost of attending a National level horse show in the spring. We are seeking sponsorships for the classes. All sponsor names will be displayed during the Derby and will be named during the presentation of the awards in their respective class(s). Class sponsors are invited to present the ribbons and trophies in their classes if they are able to attend the Derby.

Sponsorships are \$20.00 for one class or three classes for \$50.00. If you have a logo you would like to have included on your sponsorship poster, please include a clear picture of it with your sponsorship check. Be sure and designate the type of class you would like to sponsor. Remember, your donations are tax deductible.

Please note: Weather conditions may necessitate moving the Outdoor arena to the indoor arenas.

## CONDITIONS:

### 1. ENTRY FEES:

Entry Fee shall be \$5.00 for Warm-up classes and \$10.00 per class thereafter. OFFICE FEE of \$5.00 per horse.

2. **ENTRIES** must be made on the entry form provided. No entry will be accepted without signature of owner and rider. The signature of the parent or guardian of each minor rider is also required. Entries may be made the day of the show. Show office will open at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday. Numbers will be issued upon receipt of an open check.

3. **STALLS** are not available!

4. **CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS** (within 12 Months) certificate must be shown before numbers will be issued.

5. **SCHOOLING** will be permitted in the Outdoor Arena and in UPHA on Friday, September 29th from noon until 6 p.m., weather permitting. SEI approved helmets are required. Warm up will be in all arenas beginning at 6:30 a.m. on the day of the show and close at 8:15 a.m. in outdoor and 9:30 a.m. in UPHA. Rowland Arena will have the warmup jumps.

6. **RIBBONS & AWARDS** - Ribbons to sixth place will be given in every class. Championships will be awarded in hunter divisions and FABULOUS PRIZES will be awarded to the Derby winners.

7. **PETS** must be kept on a leash at all times, or they will be impounded and returned to their owners for a \$50.00 fee.

8. **CLASSES** may be canceled, combined, or divided if necessary.

9. **SHOW COMMITTEE DECISIONS** shall be final and will be guided by USEF, MHSA and MOHJO Rules where applicable.

10. **NON-COMPETING HORSES** - need to register with the secretary and pay a non- competing fee of \$25.00. A current Coggins test will need to be presented.

11. **CONCESSIONS** - There will be food available on the show grounds.

28. CHILDREN'S/ADULT AMATEUR HANDY HUNTER OF - course may include a trot fence or other handy hunter requirements.
29. CHILDREN'S/ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER UNDER SADDLE
30. MHSA MEDALLION – Open to Junior and Senior members of the MHSA. To be shown over a course of no less than 8 obstacles at a height of 2'9". Class will be judges on seat, hands, guidance, and control. Jumping faults of the mount do not count. Points will count towards the appropriate age division for the Year End Awards. Class will be split if entries warrant.
31. WWU/MOHJO HUNTER DERBY - 2'6"-3' following USHJA guidelines. There will be two rounds. The first round will have a minimum of 10 jumps with optional 3'-3" jumps. The first round is designed to emulate a hunt field with a variety of obstacle types. The second round will be a handy hunter course with optional 3'3" jumps. The second round will include obstacles that demonstrate the riders control and the horses athletic ability. There will be a fabulous prize for the winner.

First round will consist of a course of approximately 10 jumping efforts, including natural obstacles. The jump off will consist of a shortened course and in the event of an equality of jumping faults, the competitor with the fastest time will win. There will be a fabulous prize for the winner. 0.75 – 0.80
34. 0.85M – 0.95M JUMPER - USEF Table II, Sec. 1.
35. WWU HIGH JUMPING DERBY - USEF Table II, Sec 2A or B -  
First round will consist of a course of approximately 10umping efforts, including natural obstacles and terrain. The jump off will consist of a shortened course and in the event of an equality of jumping faults, the competitor with the fastest time will win. There will be a fabulous prize for the winner. 0.90M – 1.00M
