Retention Information

William Woods University is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's retention rate pursuant to title 34, subtitle B, chapter six, section 668.41(d)(4) of the Code of Federal Regulations.

In the fall of 2014, 200 full-time, first-time, bachelor's degree seeking students were enrolled. In the fall of 2015, 149 of those students re-enrolled. Thus, the university's retention rate is approximately 75%.

While reviewing this information, please bear in mind:

- Retention rates are applicable to first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students.
- The retention rate does not include students who left the school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign service of the federal government. Students who died or were totally and permanently disabled are also excluded.
