

WWU K-12 School Leader Certification Requirements

Principal Certification Requirements through MEd or EdS route

For WWU to recommend a student for K-12 principal certification, students:

- Must hold a minimum of a master's degree in **Educational Leadership** or **Administration** from WWU university. *Note: WWU EdD route is not an option for district or building level certification.
- Must pass EDU 583, Performance Assessment.
- Must pass the Missouri Content Assessment for School Leaders (Building Level Admin).
- Must have a valid Missouri teaching certificate and three years of teaching experience.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher for school leader certification coursework.

Note: If there is not an alternative for EdS students to take (No Alt for EdS), they must take the 500-level course. EdS students seeking K-12 Principal (Building Level) certification must take (in addition to their degree-seeking coursework) EDU 583, EDU 573, EDU 572, and EDU 557.

K-12 School Leader Principal Certification Coursework needed if student already holds grade specific principal certification:

- 1) EDU 583 (0.5 cr hr Performance Assessment)
- 2) EDU573
- 3) EDU572
- 4) EDU 577 (100 hr field experience)
