<sup>5</sup> No more than 70 hours can be transferred from a junior/community college.

<sup>6</sup> The BSW does not require a minor – students who choose a minor or second major may be required to take additional credit hours to meet degree requirements.

<sup>7</sup> Degree plan includes at least 30 hours of upper division (3xx/4xx) coursework in residence at WWU (degree requirement).
