

Packing List

What to Bring

The following items are suggested, not required, for residential living:

Dorm Furniture and Decor:

- Pillows, sheets and mattress cover (*XL twin beds 36" x 80"*)
- Foldable chair or blanket for outdoor events
- Posters and pictures
- LED twinkle lights
- Small trash can (*small or tall kitchen size*)
- Small refrigerator (*5 cubic ft. max*)
- Small tool kit
- Paper towels, napkins, Ziploc bags, etc.
- A few plates, glasses, and silverware (*for kitchenette on each dorm floor*)
- Keurig-type single cup coffeemaker

Organization and Cleaning:

- Laundry basket or bag
- Cleaning supplies
- Broom, dust pan, vacuum
- Plastic crates for storage
- Basket for shower items

Health and Hygiene:

- Hand sanitizer and soap
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Digital thermometer
- Tissues
- Medications
- Copy of prescriptions
- Small first aid kit
- Extra contacts/glasses

Electronics:

- Surge Protector (*power strips with breaker switch only*)
- Single outlet extension cord (*no cords with multiple plugs*)
- Fan
- Flashlight
- Batteries
- Headphones
- Desk lamp (*non-Halogen only*)

School Gear:

- Backpack/Book bag
- School supplies (*pens, pencils, notebooks, laptop, etc.*)

Clothes and Accessories:

- Umbrella
- Rubber flip-flops for shower
- Summer and winter clothing (*Missouri weather changes!*)
- Light and heavy jackets

Cards and Documents:

- ATM card (*Central Bank ATM in McNutt*)
- Health insurance and prescription cards
- Work study students will need the following documentation:
Bank account number and routing number (voided check preferred)
Original birth certificate or Social Security card
Valid driver's license or state I.D.

What NOT to Bring

These items are provided:

Wi-Fi in residence halls
Washers and dryers (*coinless*)
Microwaves

These items are not allowed:

Personal air conditioners and heaters
Extension cords with multiple plugs
Strip lights that stick to the wall

Lamps with Halogen bulbs
Incandescent string lights or incandescent twinkle lights
Candles and incense

Coffeemakers, crockpots, electric skillets, grills, toasters, microwaves and hot plates
Pets (*please refer to Student Handbook for the complete policy*)
