CLASSES: Class numbers 101-122 will be held on Saturday March 25th. Class numbers 201-222 will be held on Sunday March 26th.

ARENA: The standard (large) arena will be used for all classes. Schooling *will* be allowed in the competition arena prior to the beginning of the show and during breaks. Horses *will* be allowed in the competition arena during warm-up immediately preceding their scheduled ride times. Both competition and warm-up arenas are indoors with climate control.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Except where otherwise noted, USEF/USDF, WDAA, and MHSA rules will apply
2. No braiding required (but you can if you want to).
3. Informal attire (including paddock boots and half chaps) is allowed. **All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet, including in WDAA and Musical Freestyle tests and all warmups.**
4. **SCHOOLING:** Schooling will be open on Friday evening from 4PM to 8PM. After schooling closes at 8PM, handwalking only is allowed in the rings and warmups.
5. The 2023 USDF and USEF Dressage tests will be used for all dressage classes and are available at <https://www.usdf.org/downloads/forms/index.asp?TypePass=Tests>. The 2022 WDAA Western Dressage tests will be used for the Western Dressage TOC class and are available at <https://westerndressageassociation.org/wdaa-tests/>. 2022 USEA Eventing Dressage tests will be used for the Eventing Dressage TOC class and are available at <https://useventing.com/events-competitions/resources/dressage-tests>.
6. MAIDEN RIDER classes are open to **riders** who have never won a blue ribbon at the specified level at an USEF, USDF, WDAA, or MHSA recognized show. MAIDEN HORSE classes are open to **horses** who have never won a blue ribbon at the specified level at a USEF, USDF, WDAA, or MHSA recognized show.
7. In all TOC classes more than one test may be ridden but each test will carry a separate entry fee. State test(s) to be ridden on entry form. Classes will be split if entries permit.
8. All USEF/USDF dressage tests to be ridden in a plain snaffle except at Third Level or above, where full bridle is optional. USEF/USDF/MHSA rules for equipment apply to **all classes**.
9. Ribbons through sixth place will be awarded for all classes. High score awards will be awarded for highest overall percentage at any level on both Saturday and Sunday.
10. **ARRIVALS:** All outside competitors will receive instructions on loading/unloading, and parking via email. **Competitors may not park in the courtyards.** A negative Coggins test, dated within one year, must be submitted **with entry or entry will not be accepted.** Original Coggins hardcopy must accompany each horse arriving on the grounds.
11. **RIDE TIMES:** Tentative ride times will also be posted on the Facebook Event page and emailed by Wednesday evening. Finalized ride times will be posted to the FB page and printed at the show office on Friday evening.
12. No dogs please!
13. Light concessions on show grounds; easy access to restaurants in the area.
14. **NOTE REFUND POLICY: Entries may be cancelled for any reason prior to midnight on the closing date. AFTER MIDNIGHT ON CLOSING DATE REFUNDS ARE POSSIBLE IF YOUR REASON IS COMPELLING!!!**
