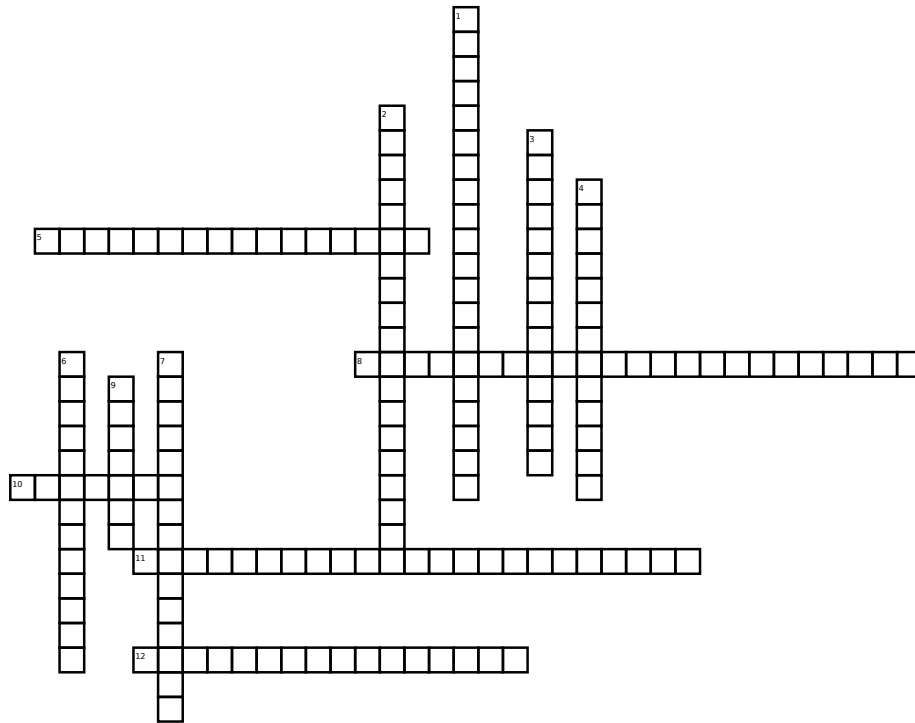


Crossword Puzzle



Down:

1. their wings have a distinct black, white and orange checkered pattern
2. From above their forewings are black with a blue iridescent hindwing and the underside has a row of bright orange spots
3. adults are small and gray with a large orange spot on their wing by the tail
4. woodland butterfly with maroon-brown wings that have blue spots lining a distinct yellow border
6. these butterflies have bold eyespots on all four of their wings
7. Missouri's ONLY green butterfly
9. looks similar to a Monarch but has an additional black vein on the hindwings

Across:

5. males are small and white with bright orange wingtips on their hooked forewings
8. Missouri's ONLY Swallowtail with yellow and black stripes
10. the males and females of this well-known and distinct butterfly can be distinguished by a small black spot on the black vein of the hindwing in males
11. the most common Fritillary in Eastern North America
12. this butterfly is named after an African mammal with similar coloration
