Graduation Rate of Student Athletes

In accordance with the Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act of 1990, William Woods University is pleased to provide the following information regarding the graduation rate of student athletes. While reviewing this information, please keep the following in mind:

- All graduation rates are applicable to first-time, full-time, undergraduate degree-seeking students and are based on up to 6 years of enrollment for bachelor's programs, which equates to 150% of the normal completion time.
- We have elected not to report transfer-out rates because our University's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in another eligible institution without completing or graduating.
- Graduation rates do not include students who left the school to serve in the U.S. Armed Forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were totally and permanently disabled.
- Men's Football and Women's Flag Football will begin in fall 2024. Data will be added for these sports next year.
