Transfer students applying to William Woods University with more than 60 hours of college credit may be eligible for exemption from the William Woods University residency requirement through the off-campus lottery process.

If the transfer student does not have 60 hours of college credit, or if there are no lottery spots available, any transfer student who did not live with a parent and lived in non-campus residential housing prior to applying to attend William Woods University (e.g. rented or leased housing), may request an exemption from the William Woods University residency requirements. Students requesting the exemption may be asked to provide proof of prior non-campus residency including, but not limited to, a copy of the lease or rental agreement signed by the student.
